

DISCLOSURE OF SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS

Sellers of real estate must now disclose in the contract, or by a separate statements, the existence of special assessments or fees against a property, or that the property is located in an improvement district. This includes special assessments for streets, sidewalks, storm water drains, sanitary sewers, parks and other similar improvements. The disclosure must be acknowledged by the buyer in writing. If the amount of the special assessments or fee is unknown, the seller must make a good faith estimate of the amount
